The Symposium on Ultrasonic Electronics (USE) is the most important annual meeting on ultrasonic technology in Japan and has the history of 26 years. The USE covers all the research fields of ultrasonics from basic theories to industrial applications. Since USE2004, the meeting has widely accepted English papers and presentations from all over the world, and one day of the three meeting days is open as the International Sessions. Over 150 papers and 300 participants are expected including an invited talk by the distinguished lecturer of IEEE UFFC. The special issue of USE is published every year in The Japanese Journal of Applied Physics (JJAP). The JJAP is one of the frequently cited international journals on applied physics. Authors of accepted proceedings papers are eligible to submit a regular paper or a brief communication to a special issue on ultrasonic electronics in JJAP.

- Deadline for application for presentation: **August 5, 2005**
- Deadline for submission of the two-page proceedings paper: **August 26, 2005**
- Deadline for pre-registration: **November 4, 2005**
- Symposium: **November 16-18, 2005**
- Deadline for submission of JJAP paper: **November 25, 2005**

The program committee reviews the paper to be accepted or rejected and mail the result to the author in September. Some papers submitted for oral presentation might be converted to poster presentation, since time for oral presentation is limited.
