1. Figures and tables, Title, Authors' names and Text

The authors of both invited and contributed papers are asked to prepare a proceedings paper of two pages in the PDF format. The submitted file of papers will be printed and included in the proceedings.

To fit the format of the proceeding, authors are requested to prepare their manuscript in the exact format shown in this example, in accordance with the following instructions.

- 1. The paper should be typed on two sheets of A4 size $(21 \text{ cm} \times 29.7 \text{ cm})$.
- 2. All materials (including title, authors, their affiliations, figures, tables, references, footnotes, etc.) must fit into an area of 17 cm (width) \times 25 cm (depth). The upper, lower, left-hand and right-hand margins should all be 2 cm. The name of the presenting author must be marked with a dagger as shown in this template. The name of presenting author who applies the Young Scientist Award must be marked with a double dagger(‡).
- 3. The title should be centered at the top, leaving at least 3 cm (6 cm from the left-hand edge) at the beginning for insertion of the identification number to be assigned by the technical program committee. Character sizes are recommended to be 16 and 11 points for the title and text, respectively. Figures (including photographs) and tables should be placed at appropriate positions within the text.

2. Figures and tables




Fig. 1 Retardation of first order diffracted light vs. Raman-Nath Parameter

Captions and labels in figures should be in English. The first appearance in the text should be in bold face, such as **Fig.1**, **Table I**.

3. Reference

It is recommended to follow the style of references used in JJAP. The examples are shown below. References of the related papers contained in the recent JJAP special issues of Ultrasonics Electronics are strongly requested.

4. Submission of manuscript

The manuscript should be converted to PDF format. The PDF file must be labeled as u[receipt number].pdf (for example, u18.pdf for the receipt number of 18), and uploaded from the url address sent from the steering committee to the authors.

The paper ID and password are necessary for the uploading. They have been sent to the author when the application of presentation was received

The deadline for the submission of proceedings papers is August 25, 2006.
